WHEREAS This type of focus on the number of visits, while disregarding the type and length of each visits, is at the expense of efficiency and effectiveness of the patient; and

WHEREAS Group Therapy, Phone contact and Family Involvement don't count towards visits in the funding formula; and

WHEREAS These services are found to be effective and efficient while the Ministry of Health appear to favour "New and Innovative" programs over the effective ones;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED That Unifor Ontario council call on the government to revise the current funding formula and work hand in hand with front line facilitators to provide the best possible services needed by those suffering and in need of assistance.
